1. Last date of Registration and submission of abstract 2nd March, 2026
2. Last date for submission of full paper 8th March, 2026
3. The abstract should not be more than 250 words, with six key words and full paper not more than 3000 words (including endnotes).
4. Paper/Articles in both English and Bengali versions will be accepted.
5. Author must submit their paper/Articles in MS Word format. Times New Roman 1.5 spacing with front size of 12 for the main text and 10 for endnotes with 1.0 spacing. PDF or another format will NOT be accepted. Kalpurush/Avra with front size 13 for the Bengali version
6. Paper must be original, plagiarism and AI detection free.
7. Selected papers shall be considered for Presentation/Publication
8. Spot Registration available and Certificate will be provided to all the participants.
