#### **Examination and Evaluation:**

Being an affiliated college, the institution meticulously follows the examination and evaluation system implements by the university. The evaluation reforms made by the university are communicated to the college prior to its implementation and training programs are arranged for the same. Internal examination is scheduled as per Institutional Level of continuous Internal Assessment after consultation with all teachers in the Teachers Council meeting. CIA-I and CIA-II are scheduled in the first half and second half respectively of every semester. It is conducted in the same pattern as that of university examination. #### **Examination and Evaluation**

Being an affiliated college, the institution meticulously follows the examination and evaluation system implements by the university.
