The college land was donated by Sri Ramkrishna Ashram, Alipurduar Junction. The foundation of the college is marked by the earnest desire of various eminent personalities and association top remote higher education in the locality. On 18/11/1986 the foundation stone of the new college building was laid by Prof. Nirmal Bose, MIC, Higher Education, Industry Et Commerce, Govt, of West Bengal. In the initial stage, classes were held in a building of Sri Durga Das Saha at Birpara Chowpati, on 3rd October, 1985. Prof. Dipti Bhusan Dutta, Vice-Chancellor, North Bengal University inaugurated the ceremonial function of its opening day and Sri Nani Bhattacharya, Hon'ble Minister of Irrigation Et Water Ways graced the occasion as Chief Guest. Other dignified and Hon'ble Speakers on the occasion were Sri Raghendra Singh. ISA, Sub-Divisional Officer, Alipurduar, Dr. B.K. Bajpair, Registrar of North Bengal University and Sri Jogendra Nath Sinh Roy, MLA. The college has succeeded in achieving several goals in its long 38 years span and is progressing with a positive attitude towards brighter future.



Merit Calculation Procedure

Merit calculation for Single Major & Single Minor:

For a Single Major and Single Minor course (4yearUG), where a student has studied the subject at +2 level = (Marks obtained in Major/related subject + Marks obtained in English + Best marks obtained in other two subjects) / 4.

For a Single Major and Single Minor course (4 year UG), where a student has not studied the subject at +2 level = (Marks obtained in English + Best marks obtained in other three subjects) / 4.

Merit calculation for three discipline specific multidisciplinary course:

For a three discipline specific Multidisciplinary course
 = (Marks obtained in English + Marks obtained in 3 Core/related subjects) / 4.

Tie Breaking Rule for admission

Tie Breaking Rule for single major and single minor:

At first, we will follow the particular major subject marks after that if tie remain same then we will follow alphabetical order and then date of birth.

Tie Breaking Rule for three discipline specific multidisciplinary course:-

We will follow alphabetical order and then date of birth.

Eligibility Criteria

- A student shall be allowed to take admission in the Single Major and Single Minor course of B.A./B.Sc. If he/ she has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.
- Provided that a candidate who has obtained- (a) 55% marks in the aggregate, or (b) 50% in the aggregate with 60% marks in a subject / related subject in the last qualifying Examination shall be eligible to apply for Single Major and Single Minor course in that subject.
- Admission shall however be on merit and availability of seats.
- Provided that for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PWD candidates- the minimum marks for eligibility shall be as per Rules of the State Government.
- Provided further that in matter of eligibility 54.5% marks or above shall be equal to 55%, 49.5% and above shall be equal to 50% and 59.5 marks or above shall be equal to 60%.

Choice of Major/Minor Courses for Single Major

- A candidate pursuing Major in a subject will not be allowed to take up the same subject as Minor.
- While taking Major & Minor subjects, availability of the said subjects in the concerned Colleges will be taken into cognizance.

Three Discipline Specific Courses (Multidisciplinary):

- A student shall be allowed to take admission in the Multidisciplinary Course of B.A. if he/she has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.
- A student shall be allowed to take admission in the Multidisciplinary Course of B.Sc. if he/she has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English and Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognized by the University as equivalent there to.

- **Good Connectivity:** Located near NH 27 and SH 16, and the Alipurduar Railway Station (500m away), making it easily accessible.

⇒ Diverse Course Offerings (Major & Multi-Disciplinary):

- The college offers a good range of Humanities majors like Bengali, Education, English, History, Political Science, and Philosophy, catering to students with varied academic interests.
- The inclusion of B.A. and B.Sc. Multi-Disciplinary Courses, including options with Geography and Physical Education, provides flexibility and allows students to explore interdisciplinary studies.

Key points of NBU FYUGP Regulation: 2024-2025

1. The University offers various undergraduate programs with multiple exit options:
 - A Certificate after completing 1 year (2 Semesters) of study.
 - A Diploma after 2 years (4 Semesters) of study.
 - A Bachelor's Degree after 3 years (6 Semesters) of study, to be completed within five years.
 - A Bachelor's Degree (with Honours/Honours with Research) after 4 years (8 Semesters), to be completed within seven years.
2. "Under Graduate Program of Study" refers to a one/two/three/four year(s) course, divided into two semesters each of six-month duration, with a maximum of eight semesters, to be pursued after successful completion of 10+2 examinations.
3. One Credit is equivalent to one hour of teaching (Theoretical or Tutorial) or two hours of Practical Work/Field Work/Extra Curricular Work per week in a semester.
4. A student must complete the 4-Year Undergraduate Program within a span of 7 years.
5. Internship is compulsory for all students and should be completed at the end of the Second or the Fourth Semester during Summer Recess.
6. For the Single Major – Single Minor Program, a student identifies one Major Course and one Minor Course at the time of admission, with the Minor being different from the Major.
7. For the Three Discipline Specific Multi – Disciplinary Program, a student identifies two Discipline Specific Courses (DSC 1, DSC 2) and one Minor course at the time of admission.
8. Students pursuing Honours with Research must have a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 7.50 or above at the end of six semesters to opt for a research stream in the fourth year.
9. A minimum of 75% attendance in classes for the course concerned and other curricular components is required to be eligible for the semester-end written Examination.
10. For admission to the Four Year Under Graduate Program, a student must pass the HS or equivalent examination.
11. For the Single Major and Single Minor Program, candidates need to have passed at least four subjects with English as compulsory in the 10+2 examination.
12. A candidate for Single Major and Single Minor Program should have either 55% marks in aggregate, or 50% in aggregate with 60% in a subject/related subject in the last qualifying examination to be eligible for that subject.
13. Admission is based on merit and seat availability.
14. The academic session normally starts in July each year, with at least 90 teaching days in each semester. There is a reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/Differently-Abled Candidates as per Government Rules.
16. For admission, there should not be a gap of more than 3 years between the year of Higher Secondary Examination and the year of admission to the Undergraduate Program.
17. Students who exit with an Undergraduate Certificate or Diploma are permitted to re-enter within 3 years and complete the Degree Program, and the total duration for completing the program will not exceed seven years.
18. To secure a qualifying grade in a Course/Semester, a student must secure an aggregate of 40% marks including Theory and Tutorial/Practical taken together.
19. A student may apply for Post-Publication Review (PPR) of theoretical answer-script(s) for a maximum of 50% of the theoretical courses, excluding OMR sheet examinations, with specific conditions for mark changes.
20. Compensatory time of 20 minutes for every hour of examination (maximum one hour) and the use of a scribe are provided for Person With Disability (PWD) students, subject to application with relevant documents.
21. Breach of discipline during examinations, such as copying, possessing incriminating materials, or misbehavior, can lead to expulsion from the examination hall and further penal action.
22. If a newly admitted student to the first semester remains absent for more than the first 15 days continuously without intimation, their admission may be terminated.
